This letter is being written to introduce you to ABATE of Wisconsin's Share The Road Program. Our Share The Road Program is available both to Driver Education classes and Community Service Groups, is presented at your facility free of charge and is approximately 40 – 60 minutes long.

*Share The Road* is a motorcycle awareness program that promotes driver awareness and increases understanding of how motorcycles behave in traffic. We hope to make drivers aware of their responsibilities toward other vehicles on the road...in particular motorcycles. Topics include: Seeing vs. Perception; Visibility; Lane Positioning; Following Distance; and Passing. ABATE of Wisconsin provides trained volunteers to present this program. We believe that education and training are the best ways to prevent and thereby reduce motorcycle / automobile crashes. We also believe that crash *prevention* is the key to reducing injuries and fatalities on our nations' highways.

ABATE of Wisconsin is a motorcycle rights, safety & education organization, not a club, dedicated to freedom of the road and is committed to motorcycle safety through rider training and motorist awareness campaigns. We serve on the Wisconsin Department of Transportation Motorcycle Safety Advisory Council, and attend related conferences including the WDTSEA Conference, Lifesavers Conference, The Governor's Highway Safety Conference and many others.
